Isaiah Lesson 18 – Isaiah 36-39 The siege of Jerusalem; Hezekiah's extension of life; Babylonian exile predicted; God's answer to Hezekiah's prayer

Isaiah 37:21-38

1. Hezekiah's prayer was **hurried** — he wasted no time.
2. Hezekiah's prayer was **heard** — verse 21.
3. God found the enemy's threats **hilarious** — verse 22.
4. God is not impressed by the enemy's **power** — verses 24-27.
5. God tells the enemy that He knows where he **lives** — verse 28.
6. God promises to lead the enemy around by his **nostrils** and send this snake back to his pit — verse 29.
7. Furthermore, God promises that the enemy will not take **Jerusalem** or even build a siege wall, or fire a single arrow into the city — verse 33.
8. Verse 35 tells us that the reason God is going to defend Jerusalem is for His own sake and for **David's** sake. This clearly speaks of preserving a **home** for the Jewish people for **Christ's** sake.
9. God kills **185,000** Assyrians outside the walls of Jerusalem as the king fled — verse 36.
10. Sennacherib went home without a victory over Judah's king or Judah's **KING** — verse 37.
11. Sennacherib **died** worshipping the wrong **god** — verse 38.
